



Mary Tavy and Brentor Primary School Guide to Home Learning

While staying at home due to coronavirus (COVID-19), parents and carers will be concerned about their children's education and the impact of missing school.

No one expects parents to act as teachers, or to provide the activities and feedback that a school would. Parents and carers should do their best to help children and support their learning. Children will be doing exactly the same work in school which means if they are in for a couple of days it doesn't matter.

This is a detailed guide on what to expect for Home Learning during the next half term.

Many schools use resources from the internet which are small teaching episodes linked to what your child is doing in school across the curriculum. You will receive a weekly timetable with links to the teaching. Inside the writing book are links and passwords to other sites.

The morning will start with a quick ZOOM meeting with your child's class teacher/ she will send you a link with a passcode and time. This is a great start to the day and the teacher will talk the children through the lessons for the day.

If you right click on the link and click on open hyperlink it will take you to the video. You can pause the video at any time and the teacher will tell you to pause if you need to answer a question.

Children will record most subjects in their writing book. Just write the date and the session. (Parents can write it for younger children)

We have provided more of a structure but realistically we know it will be difficult to keep to everyday. Don't get stressed about it and let your child take the lead. If you need to go for a walk, GO. If you have children doing different lessons at the same time, let them share the learning. It doesn't matter! If you feel your child has had too much technology, read to them.

At the end of the day there will be another Zoom meeting for children to talk about their day with their teacher.

We will provide you with their reading book, maths worksheets to accompany each video, reading comprehension and a maths book for extra maths.

Parents will be invited fortnightly to collect more worksheets, change the book and pick up any further work. (Friday 15th January) If children have completed a piece of work, please photograph it and email it to the teacher for marking. Starred work must be returned. This doesn't have to be every piece, just something the child is proud of, or a lengthy piece of writing.

Reading

- You child will have their reading book, please record their reading and take a photograph of their journal if they have earned a pot of gold..
- Each child will have a reading comprehension booklet, please complete one section every week. This is time tabled.
- Children will also have 3 teaching episodes of SPAG on their timetable.

Writing

- There will be a teaching sequence of 8-10 lessons for writing. Some lessons will require no writing, others extensive writing. They are all targeted towards particular ages. You teacher will talk to you about this on the Zoom meeting. Please email your child's writing regularly for marking. All lessons marked with a star must be returned to school.

Maths

- We follow 'White Rose' in Maths and again short teaching episodes. We have photocopied the appropriate worksheet to accompany the video. Use the pause button when requested. Please don't let your child complete the worksheets without watching the video as the teaching is really important.

Science/History/Geography and RE

- Short teaching videos with work, which should be recorded in the back of their writing books. This is linked to something your child should currently be learning in school or on occasions revision of something previously taught.

PE/Dance and Music

- There are links to 'Real PE'
- Jess our dance teacher has created some on-line lessons for us.
